To Whom It May Concern:

On January 22, 2003, I became aware that I am the victim of theft of identity. I learned about the theft of identity when The University of Kansas announced that a hacker broke into a computer database at the University. I have attached a letter from the University describing the theft. The Federal Bureau of Investigation is investigating the incident.
